OPERATION CHAKRAVYUH, CHHATTISGARH

In year 2006, as the security situation in Chhattisgarh had deteriorated badly due to intense Naxal attacks on Public places and on Security Forces, central government had decided to deploy National Security Guard to assist the state administration to control the naxal menace. On 16 Feb 2006. National Security Guard Task Force was mobilised by air from New Delhi to Chhattisgarh to conduct anti naxal operations. It was for the first time that National Security Guard was deployed for anti naxal operations by the government. The operation was code named as "Operation Chakravyuh". Over a period of 45 days, National Security Guard conducted multiple operations in which it apprehended number of naxalities and recovered large cache of arms and ammunition. The presence of National Security Guard in the region proved to be great motivation factor for State Forces to gain moral ascendancy over naxalities. After successful conduct of operation, National Security Guard was de-inducted from the area of operations.
