An independent third party Professional Inspection Body can help buyer in mitigating buyer's risk with predispatch/post-dispatch inspection in order to ensure that equipment, components, solutions and documentation conform to contractual requirements. The buyer has a right to inspect goods in reasonable manner and within reasonable time at any reasonable place as indicated in contract. Inspection Fee/ Charges (as pre-greed between bu and Inspection Agency) would be borne by the buyer as per their internal arrangement but may be recovered from the seller if the consignment failed to conform to contractual specification and got rejected by the Inspection Officer so requested and accepted by the seller , initially seller may pay for inspection charges as applicable and get the same reimbursed from buyer if consignment accepted by the Inspecting Officer . For reimbursement seller has to submit proof of payment to Inspection Agency.

Seller/OEM shall send a notice in writing / e-mail to the Inspecting officer / inspection agency specifying the place of inspection as per contract and the Inspecting officer shall on receipt of such notice notify to the seller the date antime when the stores would be inspected. The seller shall, at his own expenses, afford to the Inspecting officer, all reasonable facilities as may be necessary for satisfying himself that the stores are being and or have been manufactured in accordance with the technical particulars governing the supply. The decision of the purchaser representative /inspection authority regarding acceptance / rejection of consignment shall be final and binding on th seller.

The Seller shall provide, without any extra charge, all materials, tools, labour and assistance of every kind which the

Inspecting officer may demand of him for any test, and examination, other than special or independent test, which h shall require to be made on the seller's premises and the seller shall bear and pay all costs attendant thereon.

The seller shall also provide and deliver store / sample from consignment under inspection free of charge at any suc place other than his premises as the Inspecting officer may specify for acceptance tests for which seller/OEM does nhave the facilities or for special/ independent tests.

In the event of rejection of stores or any part thereof by the Inspecting officer basis testing outside owing to lack of t facility at sellers premises, the seller shall, on demand, pay to the buyer the costs incurred in the inspection and/or t Cost of test shall be assessed at the rate charged by the Laboratory to private persons for similar work.

Inspector shall have the right to put all the stores or materials forming part of the same or any part thereof to such t as he may like fit and proper as per QAP/governing specification. The seller shall not be entitled to object on any gro whatsoever to the method of testing adopted by the Inspecting officer.

Unless otherwise provided for in the contract, the quantity of the stores or materials expended in test will be borne k seller.

Inspecting officer is the Final Authority to Certify Performance / accept the consignment. The Inspecting officer's decision as regards the rejection shall be final and binding on the seller.

The seller shall if so required at his own expense shall mark or permit the Inspecting officer to mark all the approved stores with a recognised Government or purchaser's mark.

1. Generic

OPTION CLAUSE: The Purchaser reserves the right to increase or decrease the quantity to be ordered up to 25 percent of bid quantity at the time of placement of contract. The purchaser also reserves the right to increase the ordered quantity by up to 25% of the contracted quantity during the currency of the contract at the contracted rates. Bidders are bound to accept the orders accordingly.

2. Generic

Bidder financial standing: The bidder should not be under liquidation, court receivership or similar proceedings, should not be bankrupt. Bidder to upload undertaking to this effect with bid.

3. Generic

Bidders shall quote only those products (Part of Service delivery) in the bid which are not obsolete in the marl and has at least 7 years residual market life i.e. the offered product shall not be declared end-of-life by the OI before this period.

4. Generic

1.2. Whereas the Bidder is a private company/public company/partnership/ regis

ed export agency, constituted in accordance with the relevant law in the marand the Buyer is a Ministry of the Government of India performing its function behalf of the President of India.

2. OBJECTIVES

- 2.1. Now, therefore, the Buyer and the Bidder agree to enter into this pre-contra agreement, hereinafter referred to as Integrity Pact, to avoid all forms of contion by following a system that is fair, transparent and free from any influent unprejudiced dealing prior to, during and subsequent to the currency of the tract to be entered into with a view to:-
 - 2.1.1. Enabling the Buyer to obtain the desired defence stores at a compet e price in conformity with the defined specifications of the Services by oiding the high cost and the distortionary impact of corruption on publ rocurement, and
 - 2.1.2. Enabling bidders to abstain from bribing or any corrupt practice in ore to secure the contract by providing assurance to them that their comp ors will also refrain from bribing and other corrupt practices and the Br r will commit to prevent corruption, in any form, by their officials by f wing transparent procedures.

3. **COMMITMENTS OF THE BUYER**

- 3.1. The Buyer commits itself to the following:-
 - 3.1.1. The Buyer undertake that no official of the Buyer, connected directly o directly with the contract, will demand, take a promise for or accept, dir ly or through intermediaries, any bribe, consideration, gift, reward, favor or any material or immaterial benefit or any other advantage from the der, either for themselves or for any person, organisation or third party ated to the contract in exchange for an advantage in the bidding proce bid evaluation, contracting or implementation process related to the Coact.
 - 3.1.2. The Buyer will, during the pre-contract stage, treat all Bidders alike, a will provide to all Bidders the same information and will not provide any ch information to any particular Bidder which could afford an advantage that particular Bidder in comparison to other Bidders.
 - 3.1.3. All the officials of the Buyer will report the appropriate Government of any attempted or completed breaches of the above commitments as w as any substantial suspicion of such a breach.
- 3.2. In case of any such proceeding misconduct on the part of such official (s) is re ted by the Bidder to the Buyer with full and verifiable facts and the same is prin facie found to be correct by the Buyer, necessary disciplinary proceedings, or other action as deemed fit, including criminal proceedings may be initiated by Buyer and as such a person shall be debarred from further dealings related to contract process. In such a case while an enquiry is being conducted by the Bir the proceedings under the contract would not be stalled.

4. COMMITMENTS OF BIDDER

The Bidder commits himself to take all measures necessary to prevent corrupt ctices, unfair means and illegal activities during any stage of his bid or during a pre-contract or post contract stage in order to secure the contract or in further e to secure it and in particular commits himself to the following:-

- 4.1. The Bidder will not offer, directly or through intermediaries, any bribe, gift nsideration, reward, favour, any material or immaterial benefit or other adtage, commission, fees, brokerage or inducement to any official of the Buy connected directly or indirectly with the bidding process, or to any person, anization or third party related to the contract in exchange for any advanta in the bidding, evaluation, contracting and implementation of the Contract.
- 4.2. The Bidder further undertakes that he has not given, offered or promised t ve, directly or indirectly any bribe, gift, consideration, reward, favour, any r erial or immaterial benefit or other advantage, commission, fees, brokerag r inducement to any official of the Buyer or otherwise in procuring the Cont t or forbearing to do or having done any act in relation to the obtaining or cution of the Contract or any other contract with the Government for showi or forbearing to show favour or dis favour to any person relation to the Cor ct or any other Contract with the Government.
- 4.3. The Bidder will not collude or enter into any undisclosed agreement or und tanding with other bidders with respect to prices, specifications, certificatic subsidiary contract etc to impair the transparency, fairness and progress or e bidding process, bid evaluation, contracting and implementation of the collect.
- 4.4. The Bidder will not accept any advantage in exchange for any corrupt pra e, unfair means and illegal activities.
- 4.5. The Bidder further confirms and declares to the Buyer that the Bidder is th riginal manufacturer/integrator/authorized government sponsored export e y of the defence stores and has not engaged any individual or firm or comp y whether Indian or foreign to intercede, facilitate or in any way to recomn d to the Buyer or any of its functionaries, whether officially or unofficially to e award of the contract to the Bidder, nor has any amount been paid, prom d or intended to be paid to any such individual, firm or company in respect any such intercession, facilitation or recommendation.
- 4.6. The Bidder, either while presenting the bid or during pre-contract negotial s or before signing the contract, shall disclose any payments he has made, ommitted to or intends to make to officials of the Buyer or their family men rs, agents, brokers or any other intermediaries in connection with the contrand the details of services agreed upon for such payments.
- 4.7. The Bidder shall not use improperly, for purposes of competition or personain, or pass on to others, any information provided by the Buyer as part of business relationship, regarding plans, technical proposals and business de s, including information contained in any electronic data carrier to others a not to commit any offence under PC/IPC Act. The Bidder also undertakes t xercise due and adequate care lest any such information is divulged.
- 4.8. The Bidder commits to refrain from giving any complaint directly or throug ny other manner without supporting it will full and verifiable facts.
- 4.9. The Bidder shall not instigate or cause to instigate any third person to con t any of the actions mentioned above.
- 4.10. Foreign bidders to disclose the name and address of agents and represenves in India and Indian Bidders to disclose their foreign principals or associs.
- 4.11. Bidders will disclose the payments to be made by them to agents/brokers any other intermediary.
- 4.12. The bidder shall not approach the courts while representing the matters to Ms and he/she will await their decision in the matter.
- 4.13. In case of sub-contracting, the bidder shall take responsibility of the adopt of IP by the sub-contractor.

5. PREVIOUS TRANSGRESSION

- 5.1. The Bidder declares that no previous transgression occurred in the last the years immediately before signing of this Integrity Pact, with any other comply in any country in respect of any corrupt practices envisaged hereunder of the any Public Sector Enterprise in India or any Government Department in a that could justify bidder's exclusion from the tender process.
- 5.2. If the Bidder makes incorrect statement on this subject, Bidder can be disq ified from the tender process or the contract, if already awarded, can be te nated for such reason.

6. COMPANY CODE OF CONDUCT

6.1. Bidders are also advised to have a company code of conduct (clearly reject general than the same of bribes and other unethical behavior) and a compliance progration or the implementation of the code of conduct throughout the company.

7. SANCTIONS FOR VIOLATION

- 7.1. Any breach of the aforesaid provisions by the Bidder or any one employed him or acting on his behalf (whether with or without the knowledge of the B er) or the commission of any offence by the Bidder or any one employed by m or acting on his behalf, as defined in Chapter IX of the Indian Penal Code 60 or the Prevention of Corruption Act 1888 or any other act enacted for the evention of corruption shall entitle the Buyer to take all or any one of the fiving actions, wherever required:-
- 7.1.1. To immediately call off the pre-contract negotiations without assigning any ason or giving any compensation to the Bidder. However, the proceedings h the other bidder(s) would continue.
- 7.1.2. The Earnest Money / Security Deposit / Performance Bond shall stand forfed either fully or partially, as decided by the Buyer and the Buyer shall not be equired to assign any reason therefore.
- 7.1.3. To immediately cancel the contract, if already signed, without giving any c pensation to the Bidder.
- 7.1.4. To recover all sums already paid by the Buyer, and in case of an Indian Bic r with interest thereon at 2% higher than the prevailing Prime Lending Rate hile in case of a Bidder from a country other than India with interest thereo t 2% higher than the LIBOR. If any outstanding payment is due to the Bidd rom the Buyer in connection with any other contract for any other defence res, such outstanding payment could also be utilized to recover the aforest sum and interest.
- 7.1.5. To encash the advance bank guarantee and performance bond/warranty k d if furnished by the Bidder, in order to recover the payments, already mad y the Buyer, along with interest.
- 7.1.6. To cancel all or any other Contracts with Bidder.
- 7.1.7. To debar the Bidder from entering into any bid from the Government of Inc for minimum period of five years, which may be further extended at the distion of the Buyer.
- 7.1.8. To recover all sums paid in violation of the Pact by Bidder(s) to any middle n or agent or broker with a view to securing the contract.
- 7.1.9. If the Bidder or any employee of the Bidder or any person acting on behalf the Bidder, either directly or indirectly, is closely related to any of the office of the Buyer, or alternatively, if any close relative of an officer of the Buyer s financial interest/stake in the Bidder's firm, the same shall be disclosed by e Bidder at the time of filing of tender. Any failure to disclose the interest in

lved shall entitle the Buyer to rescind the contract without payment of any mpensation to the Bidder.

- 7.1.10. The bidder shall not lend to or borrow any money from or enter into any n etary dealings or transactions, directly or indirectly, with any employee of t Buyer, and if he does so, the Buyer shall be entitled forthwith to rescind the ntract and all other contracts with the Bidder. The Bidder shall be liable to y compensation for any loss or damage to the Buyer resulting from such ression and the Buyer shall be entitled to deduct the amount so payable from e money(s) due to the Bidder.

8. EXAMINATION OF BOOKS OF ACCOUNTS

In case of any allegation of violation of any provisions of this Integrity Pact or pa ent of commission, the Buyer or its agencies shall be entitled to examine the Bo of Accounts of the Bidder and the Bidder shall provide necessary information of relevant financial documents in English and shall extend all possible help for the rpose of such examination.

9. LAW AND PLACE OF JURISDICTION

This Pact is subject to Indian Law. The place of performance and jurisdiction is t seat of the Buyer i.e. New Delhi.

10. OTHER LEGAL ACTIONS

The actions stipulated in this Integrity Pact are without prejudice to any other legaction that may follow in accordance with the provisions of the extant law in forcelating to any civil or criminal proceedings.

11. VALIDITY

- 11.1. The validity of this Integrity Pact shall be from the date of its signing and end upto 5 years or the complete execution of the contract to the satisfaction of both the Buyer and the Bidder/Seller, whichever is later.
- 11.2. Should one or several provisions of this Pact turn out to be invalid; the reinder of this Pact remains valid. In this case, the parties will strive to come an agreement to their original intentions.
